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ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The foundation stone of this historic institute was laid way back in 1921. This college has a proud heritage of excellence and innovation. This prestigious institute is blessed as it stands in the name of the **Sixth Guru, Guru Har Gobind Sahib Ji**, who donned the swords of Miri-Piri that symbolize spiritual and temporal authority. The story of its growth from a small institution in the pre-independence India to a well-established “Seat of Learning” of the present times is a saga of dedication, conviction and vision of Late Nihang Shamsher Singh who worked against all odds and saw it growing step by step. A Gurmukhi Pathshala was established at this pious place in 1921 by Late Nihang Shamsher Singh which he preferred to call a college. The Pathshala flourished into a High School by the year 1928 and with his untiring efforts an intermediate college was started in 1948 which became a degree college later on.

It was in the year 1955 that the present G.H.G Khalsa College of Education came into being and the noble task of training the “Nation Builders” was started with the establishment of B.T with a sanctioned strength of 100 seats. The College attained the stature of post-graduate institution with the inclusion of M.Ed. in 1982.

At present, the college has a sanctioned strength of 100 seats of B.Ed. and 50 for M.Ed. course. It is permanently affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, is recognized by the N.C.T.E and has been accredited with **Grade “A”** (i.e. Very Good College) by NAAC i.e. National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore an autonomous body of U.G.C, Govt. of India consecutively for two accreditation cycles (CGPA-3.04 in cycle-I and CGPA-3.30 in cycle-II). College has attained the status of Mentor Institution under the UGC scheme / Paramarsh scheme.

The college has contributed a lot to this area by producing thousands of professionally qualified male and female teachers. The college motto “**Man Neevan, Mat Uchi**” clearly reflects its goals and mission. The main aim of the college is to produce well-informed, skilled and effective teachers for secondary schools and Colleges of Education. Besides **producing teachers for Secondary Schools, and lecturers for**

Colleges of Education, we are also producing “**Principals for Colleges of Education**”. It is interesting to note that more than 15 Colleges of Education in Punjab have Principals from this college. This college is also known as “**NURSERY OF PRINCIPALS**”.

The college results in university exams have always been around 100 percent for B.Ed and M.Ed. All the 191 students of the college have been randomly divided into 14 groups and have been assigned a mentor from the staff. INFRASTRUCTURE & LEARNING RESOURCES

The college has built a modern infrastructure in the form of multi-storey buildings for M.Ed. and B.Ed. courses, with all the requisite facilities for healthy and facilitative academic environment.

At present the college has:

- A Wi-Fi campus with leased line connection facility. The computer lab provides numerous computing facilities for its students and faculty members. The computer lab has more than 53 computers with latest operating systems and latest software. In addition the college also has Laptops, Smart board, Visualiser etc. The E.T. lab has 9 LCD projectors, 12 overhead projectors, 6 LCD televisions in addition to other equipment. ERP software developed by the college has been initiated for college automation.
- A prominent feature of the college is language lab having a facility of 20 users. It focuses on training pupils in Pronunciation, Group discussions, Extempore, Drill activities etc.
- Psychology and Guidance Laboratory has nearly 100 Psychological tests.
- The college has a fully functional Internal Quality Assurance Cell which was

established in 2009. The main aim of IQAC is planning, implementing and measuring the outcomes of academic and administrative performance of the college.

- Smart Classroom with Learning Gallery is used to teach faculty and students to integrate technology in their lives.
- The Science & Mathematics lab is well equipped with scientific devices to enhance teaching-learning process.
- Art and Craft Resource room is used to develop and nurture creative talent among the students. It is fully equipped with materials which help the students to prepare charts, models and other teaching aids.
- Sports room with Gymnasium is available within campus for the students as well as the faculty.
- College has a fully functional Research Cell in order to promote research activities among the students and the staff.
- Method Laboratory is well equipped to sharpen the teaching skills of the student teachers. It is used to record the lessons delivered by them.
- Separate hostel facilities have been provided for boys and girls with all amenities like coolers, geysers, LCD TV and computer with Internet facility.

LIBRARY

Numerous books are added to the college library stock every year, this year too the college Library Committee purchased books and journals worth Rs. 41,229. At present the college library has

It consists of number of National and International journals, educational surveys, research books, dissertations, Ph.D. theses, research oriented magazines etc. This cell provides the best resources to pursue the research work under one roof.
- In the library a Rare Section is maintained which has very old books.
