### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

The foundation stone of this historic institute was laid way back in 1921. This college has a proud heritage of excellence and innovation. This prestigious institute is blessed as it stands in the name of the **Sixth Guru, Guru Har Gobind Sahib Ji**, who donned the swords of Miri-Piri that symbolize spiritual and temporal authority. The story of its growth from a small institution in the pre-independence India to a well-established "Seat of Learning" of the present times is a saga of dedication, conviction and vision of Late Nihang Shamsheer Singh who worked against all odds and saw it growing step by step. A Gurmukhi Pathshala was established at this pious place in 1921 by Late Nihang Shamsheer Singh which he preferred to call a college. The Pathshala flourished into a High School by the year 1928 and with his untiring efforts an intermediate college was started in 1948 which became a degree college later on.

It was in the year 1955 that the present G.H.G Khalsa College of Education came into being and the noble task of training the “Nation Builders” was started with the establishment of B.T with a sanctioned strength of 100 seats. The College attained the stature of post-graduate institution with the inclusion of M.Ed. in 1982.

At present, the college has a sanctioned strength of 100 seats of B.Ed. and 50 for M.Ed. course. It is permanently affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, is recognized by the N.C.T.E and has been accredited with **Grade “A”**(i.e. Very Good College) by NAAC i.e. National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore an autonomous body of U.G.C, Govt. of India consecutively for two accreditation cycles (CGPA-3.04 in cycle-I and CGPA-3.30 in cycle-II).College has attained the status of Mentor Institution under the UGC scheme / Paramarsh scheme.

The college has contributed a lot to this area by producing thousands of professionally qualified male and female teachers. The college motto **“Man Neevan, Mat Uchi”** clearly reflects its goals and mission. The main aim of the college is to produce well-informed, skilled and effective teachers for secondary schools and Colleges of Education. Besides **producing teachers for Secondary Schools, and lecturers for Colleges of Education**, we are also producing **“Principals for Colleges of Education”**. It is interesting to note that more than 15 Colleges of Education in Punjab have Principals from this college. This college is also known as **“NURSERY OF PRINCIPALS”**.

G.H.G. Khalsa College of Education has always taken great pride in its enviable record of academic, sports and cultural activities and accomplishments. The college results in university exams have always been around 100 percent for B.Ed and M.Ed. On the cultural front, the college has won the overall trophy in Panjab University Annual Youth and Heritage festival two times and Runners Up trophy four times.

The examinations were held in the month of July 2022. **Reeta Rani with 1837 marks (91.85%) and Deepti Jain with 1808 marks (90.4) out of 2000 secured second and sixth position respectively in the Panjab University merit list. Amandeep Kaur with 1740 marks (87%) got third place in the College.** All the students passed with first division and scored above 70% marks.



**M.Ed Sem I Result (2021-23)**

Adding another feather in the cap of College, its M.Ed Semester I students (2021-23) bagged first three University positions in the final examinations conducted by Panjab University, Chandigarh. The examinations were held in the month of July 2022. Jaskiran Kaur with 394 marks out of 450 (87.56%) got first place in the Panjab University merit list. Palak Budhiraja and Kiranpreet Kaur with 383 (85.11%) and 379 (84.22%) marks respectively secured 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> positions while Himanshu with 377 marks (83.77%) is placed at 7<sup>th</sup> position in the University Merit List. A Panel discussion also followed after the deliberation by the resource persons where the attendees put forth their queries related to the various facets of NPE 2020. A book named “Post Covid Education Scenario in India” and latest issue of GHG Journal of sixth Thought- A biannual Research Journal was released on the occasion.



**National Level seminar** - College organized a one day National level seminar on the topic NEP 2020: Towards a Multidisciplinary Approach to Education on February 04, 2023. The seminar was sponsored by College Development Council, Panjab University, Chandigarh and was

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organized in collaboration with Council for Teacher Education Federation, (CTEF). Dr. Latika Sharma, Prof. and Fellow, Panjab University Chandigarh and Dr. Khushvinder Kumar, Principal M.M. Modi College, Patiala was resource person for the first and second session of the seminar respectively. The event commenced with the recitation of College Shabad followed by formal welcome of the resource persons and the other dignitaries by Dr. Manu Chaddha, Associate Prof. in the College. The dignitaries present on the occasion included Principals and faculty members of various reputed colleges and schools of the vicinity.

## **Pedagogical & Cultural activities**

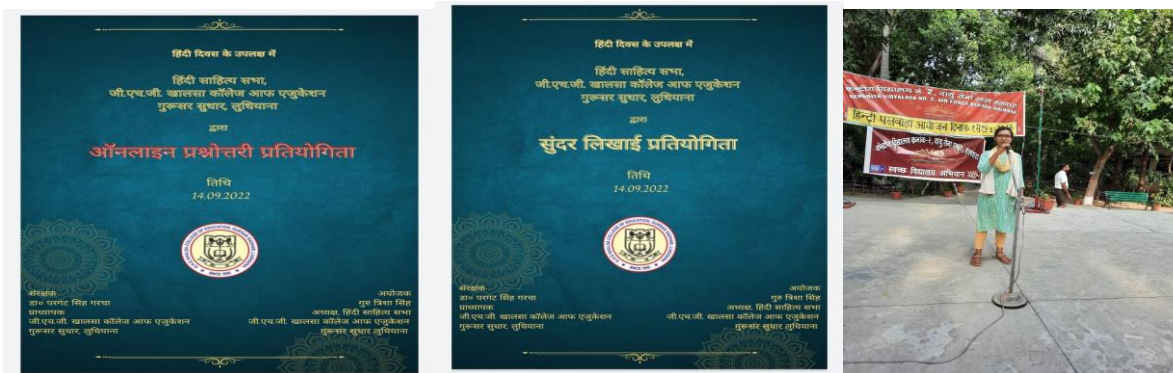
### **Mega Campus Placement Drive**

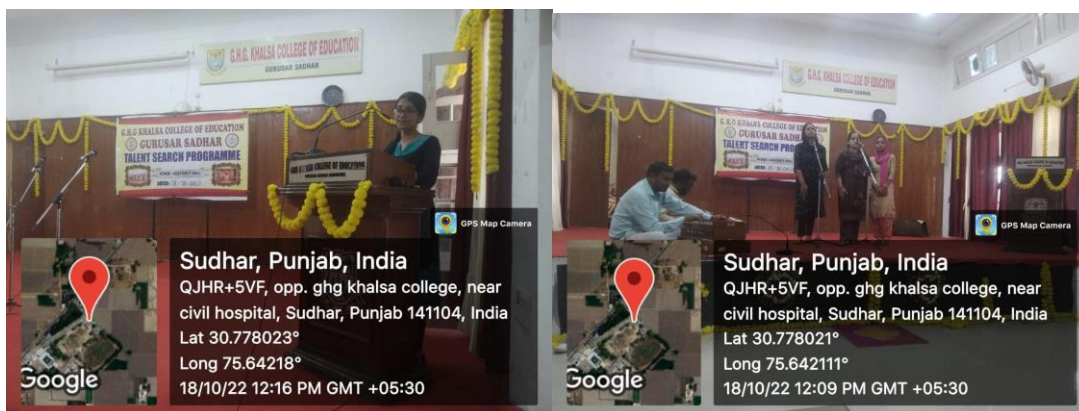




## **Talent Search**

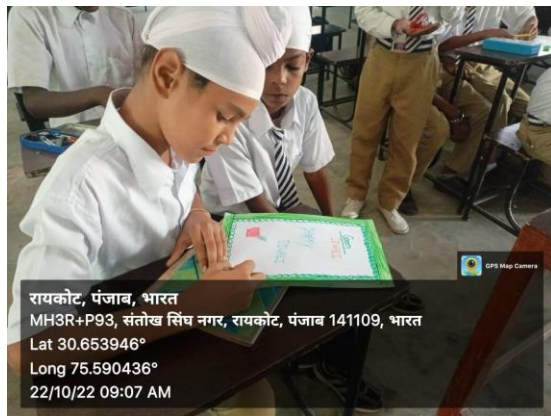




### **Green Diwali Celebration**

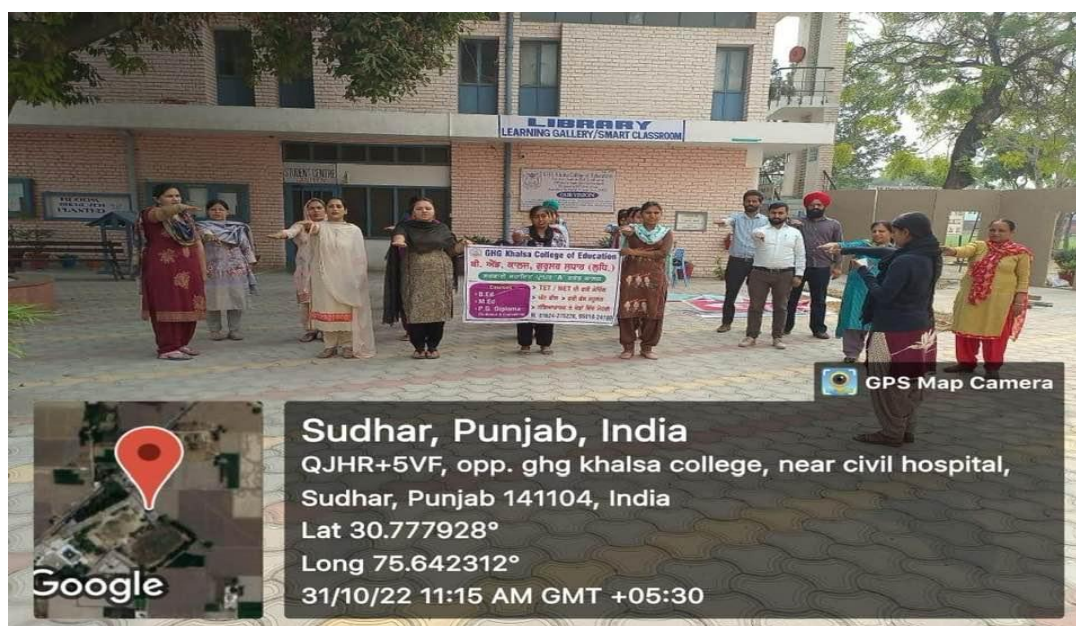
### **Educational Movie session**

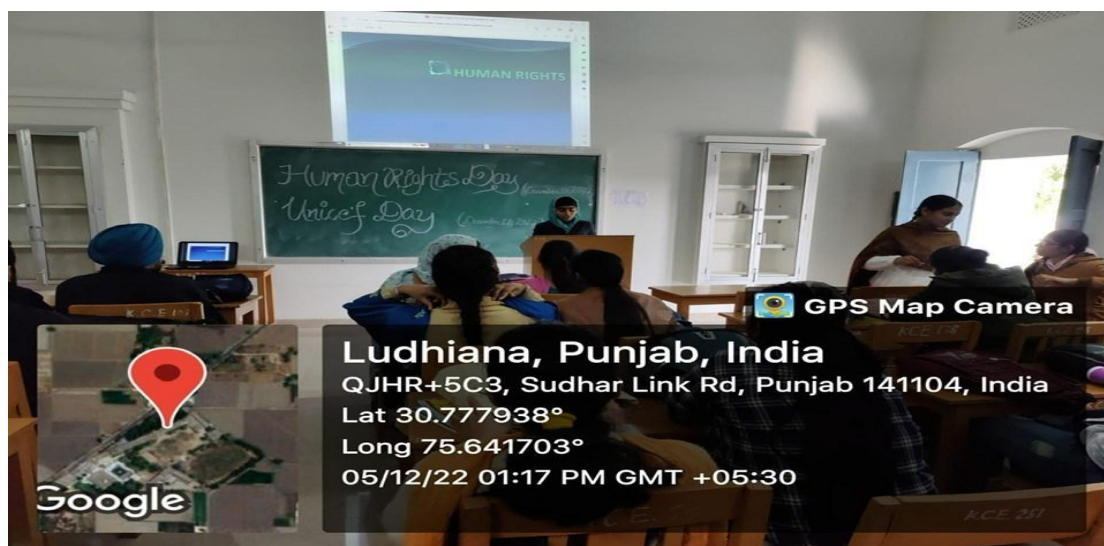


### **Celebration of Human Rights Day**

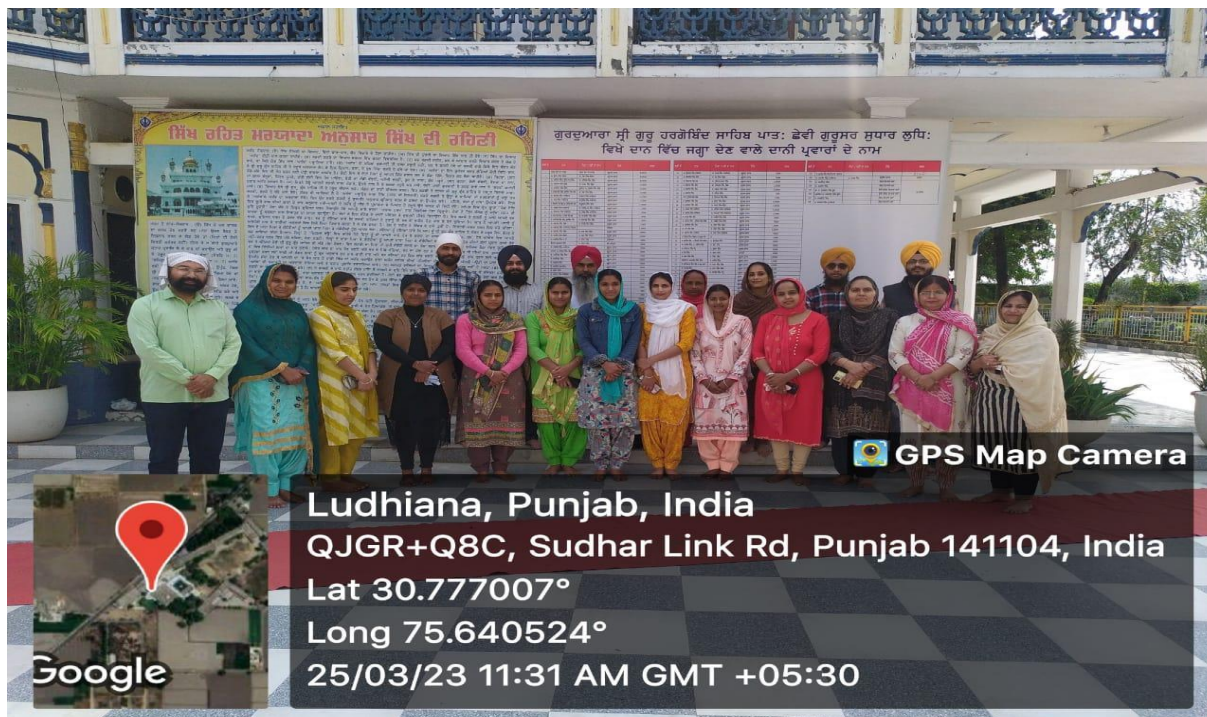






### **Celebration of Nihang Shamsheer Singh Barsi**

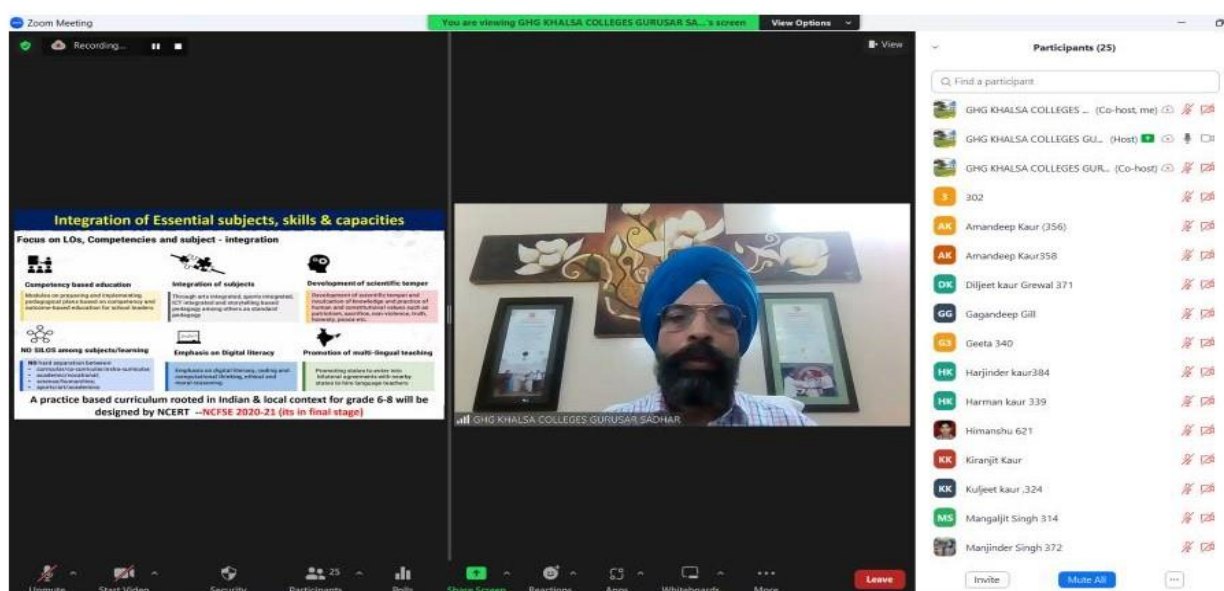
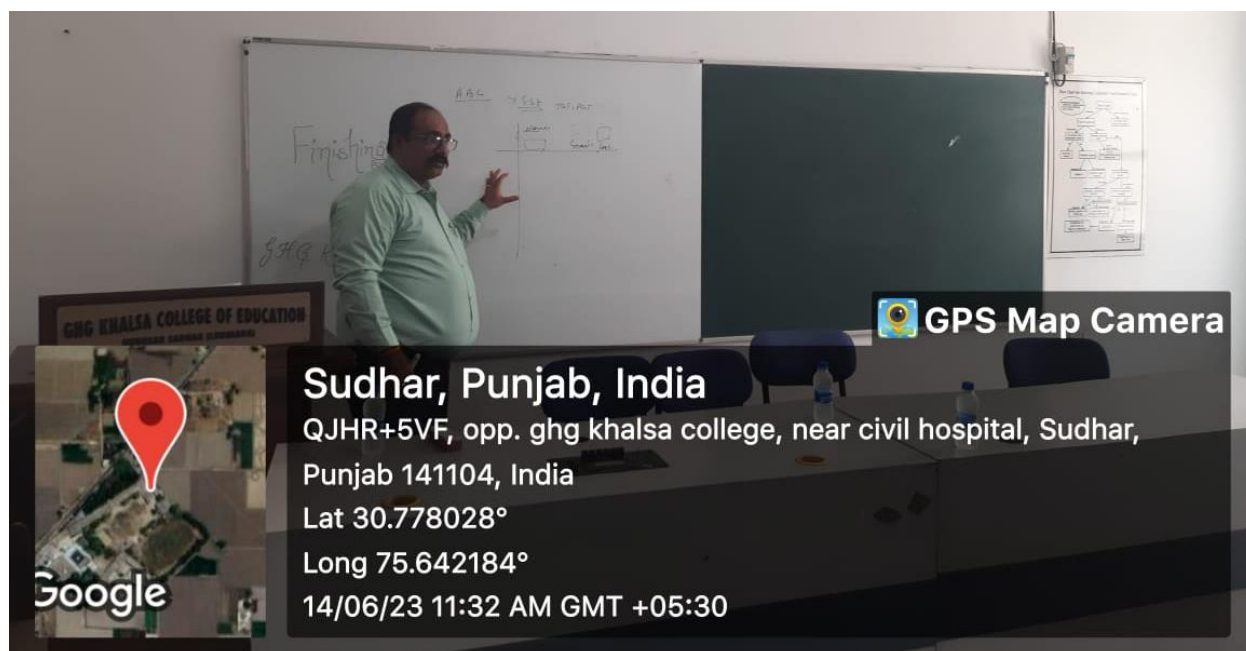

### **LIBRARY**

The institution has a very rich and resourceful library with a rare collection of books, journals and magazines. The college library is automated and all the books are barcoded thus enabling easy functioning of the library, acquiring and organizing, preserving, retrieving and disseminating information to the users, especially the circulation system. Numerous books are added to the college library stock every year, this year to the college Library Committee purchased books and journals worth's. 27,407. At present the college library has

- Library data is automated using ILMS as well as maintained manually. This software has been developed by the In-house ERP team of the college. It is fully automated. This software keeps record of all the books available in the library and an account of issue as well as return of books.
- The library provides an OPAC facility and it is available through ERP.. It provides access to WEB OPAC for its readers who can access these facilities on their personal computers/mobile with user ID s and Passwords given to them from anywhere.



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- Membership of INFLIBNET helps teachers to access e-journals and e-books on N-LIST by INFLIBNET. The username and password is issued to every teacher. They can access this facility from anywhere by using the internet.
- Seven P.Cs. with internet in the cyber Library.
- Photostat machine for students' use.
- The library has two reading rooms, one Research section, one Reference section, Administrative and Technical section, etc
- The institute has a special Research section in the library to carry out the task of research in the field of education at the post-graduation level. It consists of a number of National and International journals, educational surveys, research books, dissertations, Ph.D. theses, research oriented magazines etc. This cell provides the best resources to pursue the research work under one roof.
- In the library a Rare Section is maintained which has very old books.
