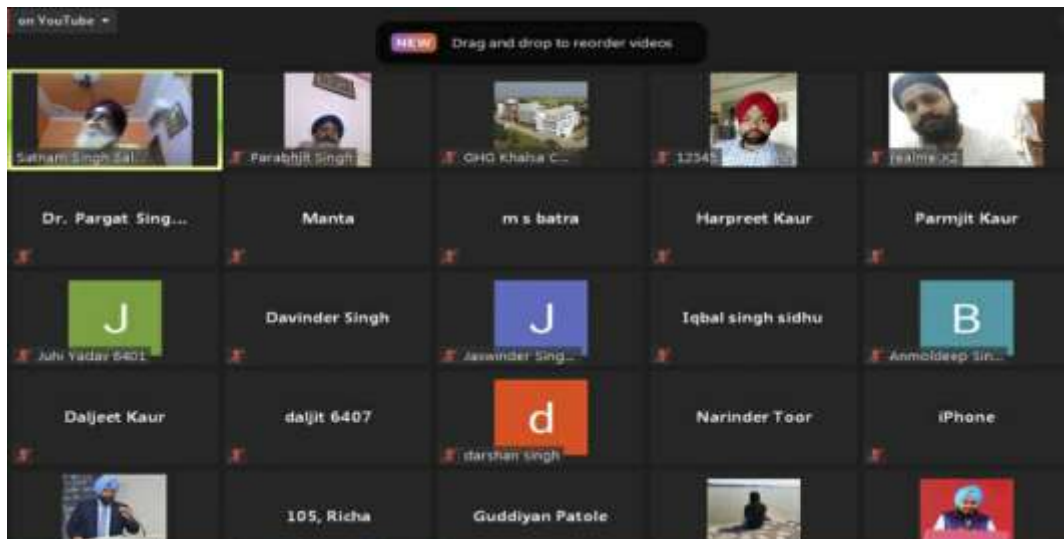


Webinar to Commemorate 400th Birth Anniversary of Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Ji (September 9, 2020)

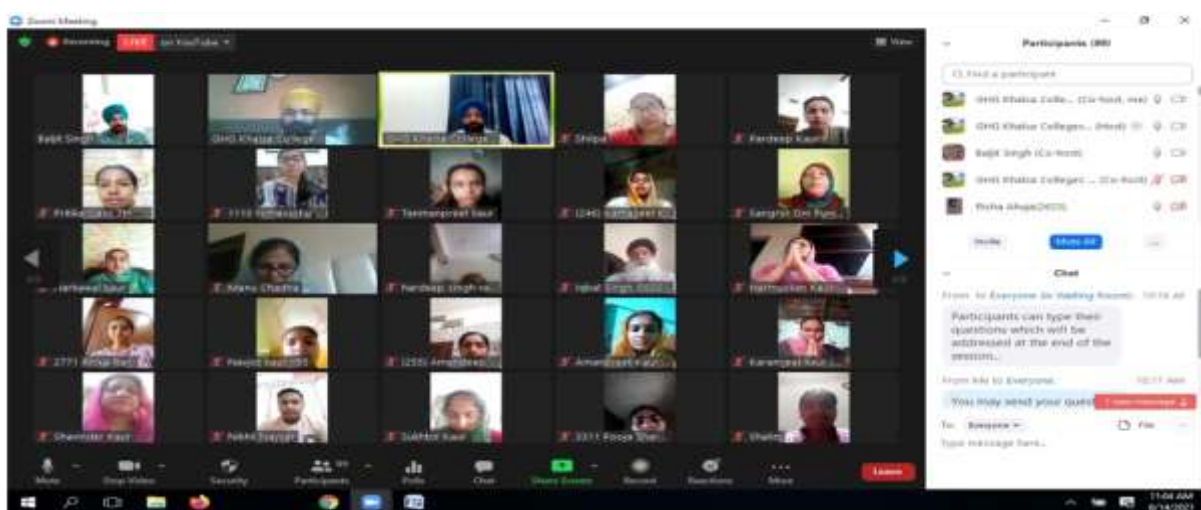
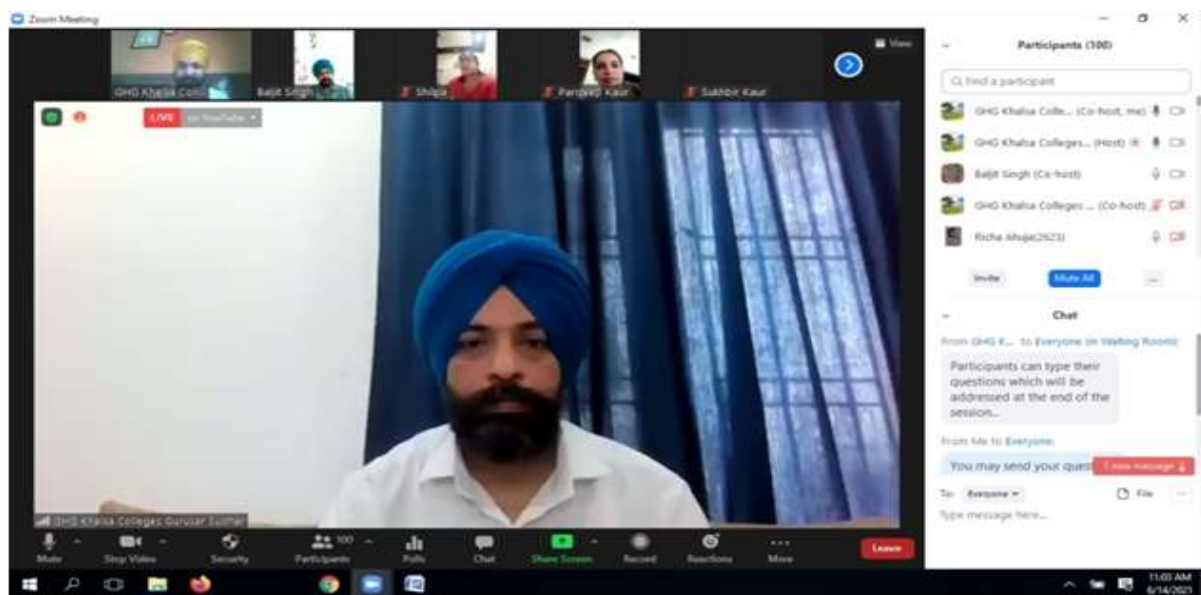


Webinar on Martyrdom Day of Shri Guru Arjan Dev Ji (June 14, 2021)
