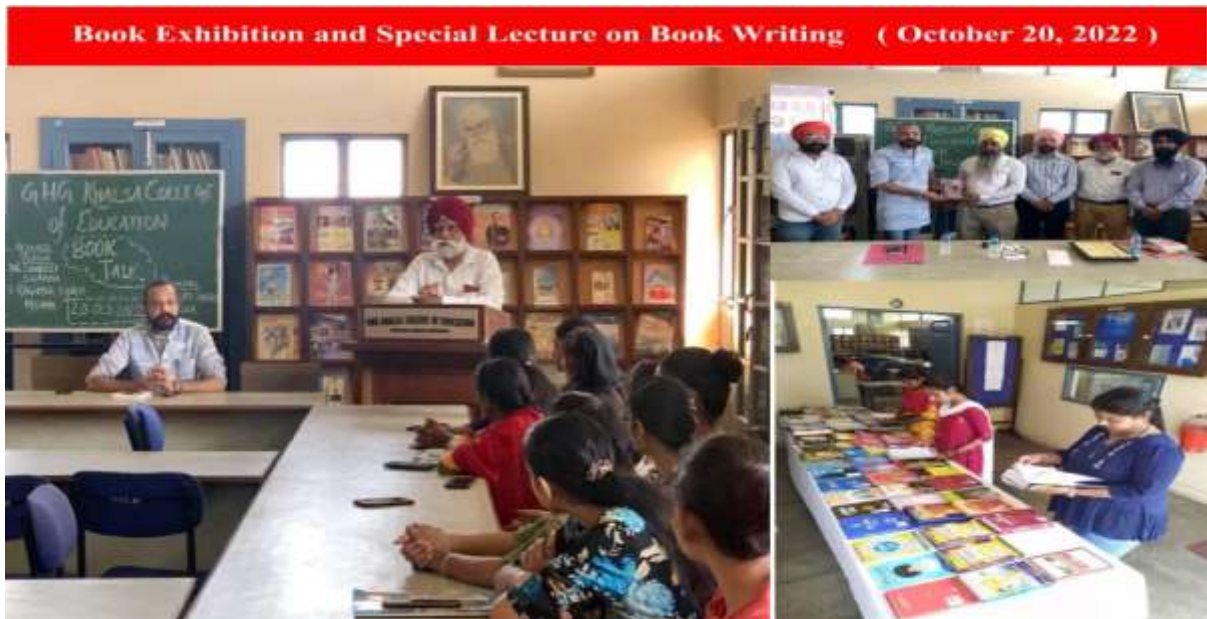


Book Exhibition and Special Lecture on Book Writing (October 20, 2022)
