



Analysis of the feedback received from teachers is given in a tabular form as under-.



ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM (HEADS OF PRACTISING SCHOOLS (2023-24)

Curriculum feedback from the heads of internship schools were collected through online mode for the session 2023-24. Review of previous years feedback was taken into consideration and a better link was established between parent institute and internship schools. Curriculum was modified and made more relevant to local needs through introduction of some new skill based courses. On most of the quality parameters heads of schools were more than satisfied as clear from the pie charts. Suggestions were also received for improvement in curriculum from heads. Quantitative analysis was done and on the various parameters chosen for curriculum feedback, the percentage of opinion and its analysis is under:

• Theory and practical components are linked to a great extent as 55% heads agree and 45% strongly agree with the statement.

• Institution worked to develop needed competencies as would be teachers among the students as (45% agree and 55% strongly agree).

• Institution also promoted self -learning skills among the students (55% agree and 35% strongly agree and 10% neutral).

• To make the curriculum more relevant and in tune with recent trends across the globe the institution incorporated new topics and techniques in curriculum (40% agree and 40% strongly agree and 20% neutral).

• Objective of wholesome personality development was achieved by the institution as(55% agree and 45% strongly agree).

• To broaden the outlook of the students and to promote mastery, institution remained successful in providing detailed knowledge of the specialized areas as reported by (60 % agree and 25 % strongly agree) views of heads.

• All the activities included in the curriculum have the spirit of self- dependence which is the need of the hour (50% agree and 40 % strongly agree).

• Students were given the best practices in preparing and using ICT skills as all of the heads were in favor of this statement.

• Efforts were made by the institution to impart interdisciplinary knowledge to the students (25% strongly agree and 50% agree).


• Along with the curricular activities students got the opportunity to explore and express themselves through the co-curricular activities as reported by 60% agree and 40% strongly agree by the heads.

• Spirit of developing professional ethics was well handled by the institution as reported by more than 80% heads.



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Analysis of curriculum Feedback from Alumni (Session 2023-24)

Feedback from Alumni for the session 2023-24 was collected in online mode. Various parameters were set for getting responses from the old students ranging from introduction of new courses to placement opportunities as well as efforts made by the institution on wholesome personality development. A detailed analysis is as under:

1. As per the feedback received from previous years, institution worked on value added and selfstudy courses in the curriculum for the current session as reported by alumni(39.6%. were agree) on this feature in the curriculum.

2. Similarly for wholesome personality development equal importance was given to co-curricular activities as reported by alumni members (66.7 % strongly agree and 31.5 agree).

3. A curriculum can be considered a useful curriculum only, if it helps in the generation of good employment opportunities especially self -employment and the feedback clearly reflects that the institution remains successful on this matter also as 48 % alumni strongly agreed and 40.7% agreed that the exposure given to them at the institutional level helped them to be employed or self- employed.

4. All the activities related to the curriculum can be carried out only, if there is appropriate infrastructure and this prerequisite is kept in mind by the institution as reported by 47.2 % who agree and 49.1 % who strongly agree.


5. As teacher education institutions are meant for developing good teaching competencies among the would-be teachers so, on this parameter also our institution gets a good percentage from the students (69.8% strongly agree and 30.2 % agree).

6. As per the feedback of alumni, the institution introduced varied value added and skill enhancement courses for the session 22-23 in the form of finishing school programme, artsy craftsy on jewelry designing etc.


7. Alumni members reported that institution provided them the opportunities for campus placement and many of them got jobs in reputed schools after completing their course as approx 90% alumni were in favor of the statement.


Curriculum helped in the all-round development of students personality. 54 responses




Curriculum generated a number of self employment opportunities for the students ⁵⁴ responses






Internship Programme carried out by the institution helped the students in developing essential teaching competencies





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Analysis of Curriculum Feedback Given by Employers (Session 2023-24)

Curriculum feedback from the employers was collected through offline mode for the session 2023-24. Review of previous year's feedback was taken into consideration and a better link was established between parent institute and employers. Curriculum was modified and made more relevant to local needs through introduction of some new skill based courses. On most of the quality parameters our employers were more than satisfied. Suggestions were also received for improvement in curriculum. Qualitative analysis was done which is as under:

Qualitative Analysis:

- Employers were of the opinion that more emphasis should be given to practical training rather than theoretical knowledge. As it has been reported by many of the employers that students lack the practical knowledge related to their field of specialization.
- Curriculum planning should be such that students are allowed to follow their personalized learning paths by enabling them to pursue subjects aligned with their career goals and passion. Focus should be on self -learning and individual learning.
- While framing the curriculum interests of the students must be considered to avoid misfits in society. Rigidity of the curriculum is the main concern expressed by many employers.
- Training of professional skills must be given to the students as a part of their curriculum. The students lack the knowledge of handling classroom crisis and providing suitable guidance and counseling to school students.
- More strong bond should be established between teachers and students trough curricular and co-curricular practices. Teaching should not be a routine task. More interpersonal affiliation should be there between students

and teachers to overcome all types of obstacles in the path of teaching and learning.

- There should be formulation of objectives and learning goals of each content area to be studied by the students.
- Incorporating texts and materials from a variety of sources and authors, including those from underrepresented groups. As more diversity in text books, more enriched experiences the students will get more will be their level of understanding and attainment.
- Offering courses or extracurricular activities that focus on diverse cultures and experiences. To address the diversity issue is altogether a need and as well as a challenge. So the institution must cater to diversity in a variety of ways so that need of each child can be fulfilled.
