Member of the Alumni, Mr. Jaskaranjeet Singh (Maths teacher in Govt School) Mr. Gurbeer Singh (Maths teacher in Govt School) could not attend the meet due to some reasons. However, it was ensured that the proceedings with the plan of action were made available to the absent members and their opinions were taken into considerations.

PLAN OF ACTION:

Dr Pargat welcomed the members and briefed them with the results and achievements of the students during the session 2019-2020.He acquainted the members with the efforts of the faculty in conducting online Final semester exams of the outgoing students.

Dr Manu Chadha read the highlights of AQAR 2019-2020 and informed the IQAC about submission and subsequent successful approval of AQAR 2019-2020 by NAAC.

 As per the suggestions by Dr. S S Thind, Secretary Managing Committee in the IQAC meeting held in March 2020 the college decided to purchase space from MOODLE for smooth conduct of classes so as to disseminate learning material to the students. The faculty has now been regularly putting their notes on LMS (ACTION TAKEN)

- The teachers had utilized their lockdown period in preparing E-content, recording it
 and uploading it on LMS as well as College YOUTUBE channel. Majority of the
 faculty had brushed their skills by joining online learning courses like MOOC on
 Plagiarism.
- 2. A Faculty Development Programme on Integrating Technology on Classroom Teaching was organized from June 26 to July 3,2020.
- 3. During Lockdown period Student teaching learning evaluation process was through online process viz Google classroom, Google Quiz. Regular feedback was provided to students. Faculty had prepared Question banks and shared with their students.
- 4. The faculty had updated their personal data on ERP.
- New email ID's have already been created for the whole staff with the college domain. The
 IQAC members suggested that the faculty members need to register themselves at
 prominent research websites like Researchgate. The institution needs to renew its
 INFLIBNET subscription which was approved by IQAC members.
- Dr H S Brar was of the opinion that faculty must be oriented and motivated to look for various online journals and make qualitative attempts for research publications.
- Dr. Pargat informed the IQAC members that NAAC has revised its Assessment and Accreditation process and the third cycle of the assessment process of the college is due in 2022.IQAC coordinator briefed the members with NAAC-RAF and then it was suggested that the planning, discussing and report writing of SSR may be started criterion wise.
- A webinar series was organized in collaboration with BTTC, Mumbai for Cultural Education and Faculty Exchange Programme under the MOU Activities with the college on September 18, 2020. The theme of the workshop was "How to Promote and Integrate Cultural Education in Primary Classroom "Another webinar to be planned in October 2020.
- Although the college was not functional in face to face mode but it did not lag behind in various academic as well as cultural activities. There were proposals regarding organizing webinars and faculty development programmes.

THE ACTIONS TAKEN WERE AS FOLLOWS:

- State level webinar to celebrate constitution day on Nov. 26, 2020

- Webinar on birth anniversary of Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji on January 19, 2021
- Seminar to commemorate 400th birth anniversary of Shri Guru Teg Bahadur Ji on January 23, 2021
- Panel discussion on NEP 2020 on Feb 04, 2021
- Seven day Faculty Development Programme on the theme "Resource Mobilization: Local to Global" from Feb 08-14, 2021.

The faculty catered to the needs of students keeping in mind the time and covid panic constraints and planned the Curriculum. Course outcomes, Unit planning to be done and put on the website .Planning the schedule and mode of Orientation sessions for new comers are the main highlights. Keeping in mind the NAAC criterion I it has been decided to revise the Feedback Performas. The faculty and criterion incharges plan to work on it.

It was decided to start a Help Desk for registration and Form Filling for B.Ed Admission once the college gets a green signal from the University. It has been brought to the notice of the colleges that The admission is to be conducted by Punjabi University through the centralized process for all the Colleges of Education situated in Punjab and affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, Punjabi University, Patiala and Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar and probably the process will start in October 2020.

Regarding withdrawal of MOU by Mentee institutions the Mentor College is in the process of identifying a new institution for mentoring under the UGC Paramarsh scheme. Dialogue with a few potential institutions is being initiated and soon a new mentee institution will be identified and intimated to NAAC

- Guru Gobind Singh Khalsa College for Women, Kamalpura- Due to the sudden rise of
 pandemic, the mentoring process slowed down for a few months, the national lock down put forth
 new challenges before the mentee institution, therefore the mentee institution expressed its
 incapability to continue with the preparations for NAAC and decided to withdraw the MOU. The
 MOU was withdrawn on June 22, 2020 and the mentee institution assured to avail the services of
 the mentor institution in the future.
- Shanti Tara College, Ahmedgarh- Due to the sudden rise of pandemic, the mentoring process slowed down for a few months, the national lock down put forth new challenges before the mentee institution, therefore the mentee institution expressed its incapability to continue with the preparations for NAAC and decided to withdraw the MOU. The Mentor institution made several attempts to motivate the mentee institution but due to sudden fall in admissions and the

accompanying challenges the mentee institution finally gave the decision of withdrawing the MOU. The mentee institution assured to prepare for NAAC assessment and avail the services of the mentor institution in the future.

Shree Atam Vallabh Jain College, Ludhiana- Due to withdrawal of MOU with Guru Gobind Singh Khalsa College for Women, Kamalpura, the Mentor College has signed a memorandum of understanding with Shree Atam Vallabh Jain College, Ludhiana on August 5, 2020 under the UGC Paramarsh scheme as per which Mentor College would be assisting the mentee institution in their process of NAAC accreditation. The institution was asked to form a steering committee and nominate a coordinator for this project. They were also suggested to update the AISHE Portal and the IQAC cell should maintain all the documents and the records for the previous 5 years.

SUGGESTIONS BY IQAC MEMBERS:

- Form teams for SSR preparation (criterion wise) and conduct regular meetings. Dr Thind directed the IQAC coordinator to plan a framework and share with the faculty involved in SSR preparation well in advance and conduct regular internal IQAC meetings to discuss NAAC criterion wise.
- Dr H S Brar emphasized that the faculty needs to be motivated to take research funding projects and for this a special FDP needs to be planned accordingly.(Action was taken in Feb 2021)
- Remedial Classes for B Ed Semester III students was suggested by Dr Jasleen Kaur. It was suggested that a definite criterion and planned strategies need to be formalized and implemented in regular time table.

The meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks by the IQAC coordinator wishing happiness and good health.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME REGARDING VARIOUS ASPECTS OF

Dr Pargat Singh Garcha welcomed the IQAC members .The IQAC Coordinator presented the highlights of the previous quarter and discussed the contribution of steering committee in the mentoring process. Dr Pargat quoted that the team has been facing some issues and needs some orientation, thereby a faculty development programme needs to be conducted .It was decided that FDP can be organized in the month of June-July 2021.

ACTION TAKEN:

Faculty Development Programme on the theme- "Quality Assessment & Enhancement in Higher Education in the Light of New Frame Work of NAAC" June 22-29,2021. The FDP was proposed to be organised under PARAMARSH Scheme of UGC in collaboration with five mentee colleges with an aim to present opportunities and challenges in the direction of quality improvement and sustenance in higher education as per the new framework of NAAC

FINISHING SCHOOL PROGRAMME FOR OUTGOING STUDENTS

With the objectives to increase employability skills and overall personality development of M.Ed and B.Ed students of the college, the IQAC proposed to organize Finishing School Programme .It was decided to organize a two week long programme. Various topics suggested were use of e-resources in teaching and learning, Workshop on CV writing, Portfolio management, Presentation Skills, critical thinking skills, creative skills, problem solving skills, Mock Interview sessions, demonstration of Blackboard Work, experiments with audio-visual material, NEP -2020 etc. The tentative dates decided were June-July,2021.

VACCINATION DRIVE FOR FACULTY

Dr. Pargat Singh Garcha, Principal of the Mentor institution and the entire standing committee congratulated the Management, the Principal Dr. Savita Uppal, Ms. Suksham Ahluwalia, Coordinator IQAC and the entire steering committee and staff of Arya College for their commendable results. The mentee institution extended their heartfelt thanks to the mentor college for their support and guidance for the NAAC accreditation.

- Meeting Of The Standing Committee In The Campus- A meeting of the standing committee was held in the office of Principal on March 2,2021 to discuss the future course of action in giving guidance to the mentee colleges. The meeting was chaired by the Accreditation Ambassador Dr. H.S. Brar. A questionnaire of doubts and clarifications in answering certain questions from SSR received from AVJ College, Ludhiana was discussed. An on campus meeting with the Mentee institution was also planned so as to offer advice and suggestions in preparing SSR and other maintenance of records.
- Mock NAAC Visit -I and II to Arya College, Ludhiana- A four member team comprising Dr.
 H.S. Brar, Dr. Pargat Singh Garcha, Dr. Manu Chadha and Mr. Harpal Singh from the Mentor
 institution visited Arya College, Ludhiana on March 5, 2021. The purpose of the visit was to
 conduct Mock NAAC in the mentee institution. The team also reviewed the best practices of the
 college and gave the necessary feedback.

A four member team comprising of Dr. H.S. Brar, Dr. Pargat Singh Garcha, Dr. Manu Chadha and Dr. Jasleen Kaur visited Arya college, Ludhiana on March 13, 2021. This was the second part of the Mock NAAC visit. The team observed the departmental presentations of the mentee college and all the necessary suggestion were given post each presentation. A collective feedback and suggestions for improvement were given at the end of all presentations the efforts of the mentee college were duly appreciated. The team also met the Secretary of the Managing Committee and shared the feedback of the observations during the two day Mock.
