



Associate Professor and Vice President at HSNCU (University Affair) BTTC, Mumbai


A session was conducted in online mode for students of B.Ed. and M.Ed sem IV on June 7,2023 by Dr. Mandeep Kaur Kochar, Associate Professor and Vice President at HSNCU (University Affair) BTTC, Mumbai. In the session she discussed the 7Cs Approach for Self Confidence. 


Day 3 (June 9th, 2023)

Assistant Professor, GHG Khalsa College of Education, Gurusar Sadhar, Ludhiana



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Day 4 (June 10th, 2023) Mr. Amandeep Singh Principal, GSSS, Boparai Kalan



Day 5 (June 12th, 2023) Mr. Amandeep Singh Principal GSSS, Littar

The fifth day of the Value Added Course on professional competence was conducted in online mode. The resource person for the day was Mr. Amandeep Singh, Principal GSSS, Litter. He deliberated on the topic 'Career Guidance'. He started his topic with the famous saying that 'A healthy mind lives in a healthy body'. So for maintaining good mental health we have to adopt healthy strategies in life. He dealt with various issues related to career guidance and counseling for the school students. In his talk he emphasized on various personality traits of being a good teacher as well as some tips for appearing for a job interview. He told students that the role of a teacher should not be only teaching the subjects but also some life skills to the students. Teaching should be experience based. A teacher can act as a counselor and facilitator. He should serve as a bridge and start from the basic level of the students including his age, grade and maturity level. Sir also narrated a few stories to clear the role of the teacher and his place in the society. He informed students that, it is more important that what you learn rather than what your teacher teaches you. He motivated students that for being a good teacher, you have a firm belief in the abilities of each student and you should try to guide them and counsel them to the best of

their abilities and their potential. Overall the lecture was a very interactive one. Sir satisfied the queries of most of the students and also guided them for their future pursuits.



Day 6 (June 13th, 2023)

The sixth day of the Value Added Course on professional competence was held in online mode. The resource person for the day was Dr. Manu Chadha, Associate Professor from the host college. She deliberated on the topic 'Coping Mechanism'. Dr Manu started her lecture with some facts about the rapid rise of stress and depression among the youth, especially among the school going population. She told students that, no doubt we all are victims of stress but we all have the capacity as human beings to cope with stressful situations. For using effective coping strategies, first we all must know the sources of our stress and types of coping mechanisms we have at our disposal. She differentiated between defense mechanisms and coping mechanisms that can be used for dealing with day to day stress. Dr. Manu further elaborated on the theme by sharing some commonly used adaptive coping strategies including support, relaxation, problem solving etc. To give some practical exposure to the students Dr. Manu asked students to prepare a worksheet comprising the methods they can adopt to deal with panic and anxiety situations. For this they have to imagine the threats in their life and rate them from 1 to 10 depending upon the severity of the situation. Along with the seriousness of the situation, they also have to write about

the way they will adapt, to cope with these stressful situations. Majority of the students prepared a worksheet and shared their threats and coping strategies with the resource person. Overall the session was a very interactive one. Dr. Manu also shared a sample coping skills worksheet at the end of the session.




Day 7 (June 14th, 2023) Dr. Jasdeep Kaur

The sixth day of the Value Added Course on professional competence started in online mode and the theme for the day was 'Workshop on CV: Role of CV/Resume. The resource person Dr. Jasdeep Kaur, Assistant Professor from BCM College of Education started her talk with the concept of resume writing and its key elements. She also differentiated between the terms CV versus Resume. Dr. Jasdeep suggested students to be clear in their career objectives before preparing their resume. Resume should include the basic information, educational background as well as 2 to 3 references of the people, who know well about the various traits of your personality. After discussing all about the basics of resume writing the resource person conducted an online workshop for creating a resume. Most of the students participated and created their resume side by side. After this practice Dr. Jasdeep intimated students about the cover letter which is an essential part of good resume writing. She shared tips for writing a good cover letter and the ways for selecting online templates for writing an effective cover letter. In the last she summarized the whole session and also shared the web address which can help

students in making CV or Resume for their future employment opportunities. Overall the session was a very effective and interactive one.



Day 7(June 14th, 2023)

The seventh day of the Value Added Course on professional competence was conducted in offline mode. The resource person for this offline session was Mr. Chander Shekhar, Principal, Jatindra Greenfield School, Ghuman. His topic of deliberation was how to prepare for a job interview. He discussed in length about the rules and regulations to be followed for appearing in an interview. He informed students that, an employer looks upon so many aspects of his employee including, his talk, level of confidence, mannerism, communication skills, personality traits and above all the subject knowledge and dedication and commitment towards the job. He suggested students that while applying for any job, prepare a good CV beforehand and write only about the qualities, traits or hobbies which they actually possess. Thus it is not advisable to give wrong facts as it will leave a bad impression on the employer. He also advised students to be confident, make some negotiations, show their eagerness to join this job and convince the employer about your merits and your abilities of being a good teacher as well as mentor. Mr. Shekar quoted many examples from his personal life as an employer and satisfied all the queries of the students in an effective manner. Overall the session was a very interactive one. Students

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got useful tips for preparing for an interview. At the end of the session he conducted mock interviews and informed the participants about their shortcomings and ways to improve before going for an actual job interview.




Day 8 (June 15th, 2023)




Day 9 (June 16th, 2023) Dr. Jasvir Kaur Chahal
